4	Financial Report	Treasurer	The branch is in very good financial shape with \$3,060.46 in the bank and no immediate commitments. This is due to the 2 donations we received last FY totaling \$2,500. There was discussion as to whether the branch needed the \$950 (\$10 per Associate member) the
